Duracoat™ will now be used exclusively to line all of the city's manholes slated for renewal. Duracoat™ will provide Naperville with compressive strengths in excess of 15,000 psi and Chloride-Ion Penetration Resistance of 300 Coulombs. These features (and others) will ensure that the City of Naperville's manholes have the longest anticipated life-cycle at the most cost-effective price. CWR's Lifespan System® will also be used in the renewal of manholes and will replace all existing frames, covers and adjustment risers, ensuring that inflow and infiltration into the sewer system is minimized. Severson knows the benefits of eliminating leaks from their collection system. "City Council demands that we keep the collection system performing, even during heavy rains. After over 16 years, we know first-hand the benefits of keeping leaks in our system to a minimum, which in turn leads to fewer overflows and basement backups." According to Severson, the tops of the manholes "are one of the first parts of the collection system to fail." Added Severson, "it is simply the smartest system for the top of manhole structures I have ever seen. We never want to go back to a structure we have already fixed. We consider Lifespan to be "best in class" which will allow us to do the job right the first time and have it last."

Both products will be distributed by Kenny Construction Company (Wheeling, IL). Jack Callahan, Vice President of Kenny adds that "the Lifespan frame weighs about 65 lbs, so from a worker safety perspective, this is a great feature of The Lifespan System® and a big improvement regarding safety and performance in general."
